So what is next?! This week we are going to take our first test. Our math test on Tuesday will cover everything we learned about with place value. Make sure you look over extended form. That seems to still be a little

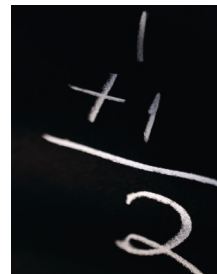
tricky for some of you.
