

BUS RULES

STUDENTS MUST:

1. Load and unload as explained by the driver. If you cross in front of the bus, wait for the driver to turn on the flashers, make eye contact with the driver, and the driver will motion you to cross the street. ALWAYS WALK 10 FEET IN FRONT OF THE BUS. If you walk too close, the driver cannot see you!
2. You must be standing at the bus stop when the bus approaches the stop. Do not wait in the car until the bus stops at the stop. Do not wait in the house until the bus stops. The bus will leave you if you are not standing at the stop.
3. Park/drop off student on same side of street the bus picks up on. Do not park across the street and have your child cross in front of the bus! Remain seated and facing front at all times.
4. Ride in assigned seats.
5. Keep the bus aisles clear at all times.
6. Obey all instructions of the driver.
7. Talk quietly.
8. Be silent at railroad crossings.
9. Be courteous at all times.

STUDENTS MUST NOT:

10. Put any part of their bodies out of the windows.
11. Fight or hit others.
12. Throw objects
13. Take items belonging to others.
14. Smoke or light matches.
15. Use or carry fireworks.
16. Open the emergency door.
17. Handle the radio or safety equipment.
18. Touch the controls of the bus.
19. Damage the bus or seats in any way.
20. Bring animals or hazardous cargo on the bus.
21. Eat, drink or chew gum.
22. Litter the bus.
23. Use profane or abusive language.
24. Behave in a disorderly manner.
